### COLLGAR WIND FARM

#### ABOUT COLLGAR

Collgar Wind Farm Pty Ltd (Collgar) is owned 60% by the UBS International Infrastructure Fund (UBS) and 40% by the Retail Employees Superannuation Trust (REST).

UBS is managed by UBS Asset Management, a global firm providing financial services to private, corporate and institutional clients. REST was established in 1988. Open to all Australians, it is Australia’s largest superannuation fund by membership, with over 2 million members and more than \$39 billion of funds under management. UBS and REST are both substantial long-term investors.



#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Collgar is a \$750 million renewable energy project consisting of 111 wind turbines located approximately 25km south-east of Merredin in Western Australia, with a generation capacity of 206 Megawatts. It is the largest wind farm in WA and the largest single-stage wind farm development in the southern hemisphere to date. The project location was selected for its unique topography, world-class wind resource, favourable community rapport and proximity to the power grid.

### COLLGAR COMMUNITY FUND

The Collgar Community Fund (CCF), established by Collgar, provides sponsorship to fund local projects that benefit the Shire of Merredin and surrounding areas. Through the CCF, Collgar supports initiatives that strengthen the local community through programs that enhance the Merredin region and surrounding areas.

A Grants Committee has been appointed to assess all applications and determine how best to allocate funds and in-kind contributions to maximise benefits for the community.

Applicants must be from Merredin or the surrounding shires and be one of the following:

- Not-for-profit organisation
- Local government
- Educational department or group
- Incorporated community-based organisation
